- ☞ **Rs. 1,203.85 Lakhs disbursed to 4,700 farmers in the five 'Integrated Cooperative Development project (ICDP)' districts of Kohima, Tuensang, Kiphire, Longleng and Peren.**
- ☞ **Agri and allied activities, weaving & handicrafts, marketing activities, etc. under ICD project has covered 188 cooperative societies in 94 villages.**
- ☞ **Under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) 640 piglets disbursed to 1280 farmers under 64 Commodity Interested Group (CIG) formed.**
- ☞ **Assistance towards feeds for piggery units disbursed to 64 CIGs.**
